The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Renee Westover, Todd Duke, Brad Lambright, Susan Hamilton and Andy Wandersee. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Todd Duke, second by Andy Wandersee, to approve the consent items as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Brad Lambright opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Mr. Lambright.

Old Business:

- The school board passed a resolution and agreement for the town of Centerville to provide a student resource officer in our schools for the next three years. Motion by Todd Duke, seconded by Andy Wandersee to approve. 5 ayes - 0 nays.
- The school board approved the HELP lease to pay for the security cameras and door entry devices in the school buildings. Motion by Susan Hamilton, seconded by Renee Westover to approve. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

New Business:

- Mr. Sean Stevenson, Mr. Bellew, and Mr. Hollendonner, presented proposed 2019 – 2020 student handbook changes for school buildings to the Board of Trustees for consideration. Tabled for further discussion.
- The school board approved the Common School Loan application. Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Andy Wandersee to approve. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Stevenson explained the new state law concerning accepting kindergarten students that are age five after August 1 for the 2019-20 school year if they pass the required tests. The general assembly will now fund these students. Our school currently has five of these students. No action was required.

Additional Items:

- Mr. Hollendonner discussed plans on how the football field turf can be repaired at no cost. No action was required..
- Mr. Stevenson presented an additional transfer students request for consideration. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Todd Duke, to approve the additional transfer students request as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Stevenson presented an additional employment report for consideration. Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Todd Duke, to approve. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

- Mrs. Hamilton made a report on the meeting with the auditors. She stated that the auditors are requiring more sign-offs on reports by another individual in the office mainly on federal reports.
- Mr. Lambright reported that he missed the School Improvement Meeting at Centerville-Abington Elementary but he would report on it at the next board meeting..
- Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Todd Duke, to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 PM. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
