The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 6:00 p.m. at Centerville-Abington Junior High for a work session. The following members were present for the work session: Todd Duke, Renee Westover, Brad Lambright, and Susan Hamilton.

The work session concerned maintenance and project needs of the school corporation. In addition, classrooms were available to tour.

Dr. McCoy and Mr. Sean Stevenson provided a project list with thirty-seven needs identified. Other concerns were shared by administrators during the tour.

The work session started with twelve desired projects for the athletic facilities overseen by Mr. Osting. Mr. Stevenson gave the junior high tour with its three potential projects.

Mr. Hollendonner and Mr. Bellew provided the tour of CHS and three projects there. In addition, roof leaks in the science wing were mentioned as was the status of the greenhouse.

Mrs. Van Winkle led the tour of Centerville-Abington Elementary school. She shared the concerns with the construction progress and how the classrooms will be assigned in the fall of 2021. She reported the third grade reading test had 89% pass rate for the first round of testing. With the COVID interruptions last spring and this fall, this result was a credit to the teaching staff's dedication. Plans are being made for the summer reading program for the third graders.

At Rose Hamilton, Mr. Pritchard had 3 project concerns, outlined the PTO project to make an alcove between the cafeteria and preschool wing into an age-appropriate playground for preschool children, and shared ideas for the two interior courtyards.

Cost for all project needs will be developed. Those projects for which ESSER funding is available will be identified. A future work session may be necessary to prioritize all the projects.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Todd Duke to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m. Those voting in favor were: Renee Westover, Susan Hamilton, Todd Duke, and Brad Lambright. Motion passed 4-0.
