GRAB-N-GO CRAFT KITS

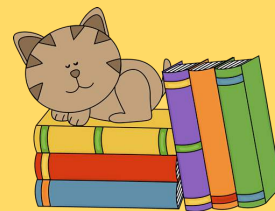
- We have craft kits available for all ages!
